Disaster Recovery Center:

The Disaster Recovery Center (DRC) is open at the Clay County Fairgrounds, 2497 State Road 16 West, Building 3, Green Cove Springs, daily from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. through Friday, Sept. 29.

Clay Transit will be providing complimentary transportation to the Disaster Recovery Center (DRC) Wednesday, Thursday and Friday.

For residents in Orange Park\Middleburg Area:

- Departure will be from the Orange Park Mall at 8:30 a.m. with expected arrival at the DRC at 9:45 a.m.
- Return trip from the DRC departs at 1:30 p.m. arriving at the Orange Park Mall at 3:50 p.m.
- Note: Transportation to/from Orange Park Mall will be provided through Clay Transit connections with The Red Line, Blue Line and Green Lines. Connection times can be obtained through the Clay Transit website at www.claytransit.com

For residents from Keystone Heights Area:

- Departure will be from the Keystone Senior Center at 8:25 a.m. with expected arrival at 8:55 a.m.
- Return trip will depart from the DRC at 4:20 p.m. and arrive at the Senior Center at 4:50 p.m.

Fares will not be assessed for transportation to/from the DRC. Clients will be required to notify driver of necessity to stop at the DRC location to avoid charges/fares.

Mosquito Control Report

As of today, 65% of the county has been sprayed by our local mosquito spray truck, locally contracted trucks and state contracted trucks. Nine trucks have traveled more than 300 miles of our county spraying EPA approved insecticides with the intent to maintain public health.

Road Closures / Road Work

The County Road 218 Bridge remains closed. An engineering firm has been contracted and a project timeline is forthcoming.

Road work on Henley Road is expected to be completed mid-December 2017. No left turns from Henley Road onto Russell Road will be allowed daily from 3:30 p.m. – 6:30 p.m. beginning Sept. 27
