County Road 218 Bridge Update

We understand the community's frustration with this bridge closure. Scouring from the significant flooding from Hurricane Irma caused the damage to the bridge. After underwater inspection, the bridge was closed. We have executed all of our emergency procedures and now have a contractor on board, Leware Construction Company, from Leesburg, FL to repair the bridge. We anticipate the bridge construction to be completed on or before December 23, 2017. Thank you for your patience as we move forward with this project.

Army Corps of Engineers' Blue Roof Project

When: Thursday, Oct. 5 – Friday, Oct. 13 - 8:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m.

What: Operation Blue Roof provides no-cost temporary repairs for roofs damaged by Hurricane Irma. The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers contractors will install the temporary roof covering at **NO COST TO YOU**. Only primary residences with standard shingled roofs are eligible for the program. Metal roofs and mobile homes will be repaired as practical on a case by case basis. Roofs with greater than 50 percent structural damage are not eligible. To get assistance, you must sign a "Right of Entry" (ROE) form to allow Corps staff and contractors to access your private property and assess roof damage.
