In 2020, the Green Cove Springs Police Department had a total of five (5) administrative investigations opened.

Out of the five cases opened in 2020, four (4) were classified as Supervisor Reviews (SR's) and only one (1) was classified as an Internal Affairs Investigation (IA).

In the Internal Affairs Investigation, all of the charges stemmed from minor omissions made by the officer on his job application with the City. Two instances were found to be "Sustained" against the officer. Three instances against this officer were found to be "Not Sustained" and seven instances were found to be "Unfounded." It should be noted that none of the omissions were of any real consequence.

In the first Supervisor Review, the officer was found to be in possible violation of the Department's Off-Duty Conduct Policy and Handling of Personal Disputes.

In the second Supervisor Review, a civilian member was found to be in possible violation of the Department's policies regarding Transferring of Medical Calls and Documentation of Calls.

In the third Supervisor Review, the charge against the officer of Rudeness was found to be "Unsustained."
